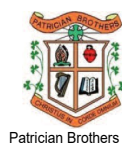

Workshops

1. Teaching and Technology Killinure Suite

Facilitators: Aine Moran, Principal Le Chéile Secondary School and Colm Mythen, Principal, Ardscoil La Salle, Raheny

Le Chéile Secondary School; a school with no books! Aine will share her school's experience of using technology to extend learning and build community. Colm will share the experience of implementing a Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) model **on a budget**. He will lead a discussion of the benefits and the pitfalls that Ardscoil La Salle has encountered over the last 4 years.

2. Leadership and Me! Lecarrow 1 Suite

Facilitator: Sean Ruth, Psychologist and author of *High Quality Leadership: A self-assessment Guide for Individuals and Teams*

This workshop will explore such areas as identifying strengths as leaders; the challenges facing leaders; dealing with other people's reactions to leaders; effects on leaders; and coping strategies - personal and organisational. Sean Ruth places particular emphasis on the importance of listening and his rule of thumb is *'You can listen people into agreement a lot more quickly than you can argue them'*

3. How Not to be Afraid of the Media!
