a programme which will focus on physical and mental health issues. The girls were given a

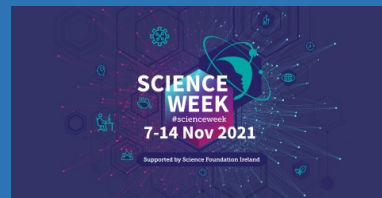
recipe booklet full of delicious and healthy recipes for breakfast, lunch and dinner.....
